

ACCEPTABLE WASTE

| CATEGORY | EXAMPLES |
|----------------------------|---|
| Construction Waste | Drywall, Lath & Plaster Lumber (Painted or Unpainted) Roofing Shingles Doors & Windows |
| Furniture | Beds, Box-springs Sofas, Armchairs, Recliners Tables, Chairs, Desks |
| Appliances | Stoves, Microwave Ovens Fridges, Freezers ¹ Air Conditioners ¹ |
| Bulky Recyclable Materials | Steel Tires ² |
| Brush | Tree Limbs and Trunks ³ Hedge trimmings |

1. An environmental surcharge will apply.
2. Only standard-sized personal vehicle tires (including ½ ton trucks) will be accepted.
3. Maximum size permitted: 24" in diameter; tree stumps will not be accepted.

PROHIBITED WASTE

| CATEGORY | EXAMPLES | DISPOSAL OPTIONS |

| Domestic Garbage | Food waste Toiletries Vegetable waste | Curbside garbage collection service, and backyard composters for vegetable waste. |
| Domestic Recyclables | Glass & plastic bottles Food cans Cardboard Newspapers, magazines | Curbside recycling collection service. |
| Yard & Garden Waste | Grass clippings. Vegetable garden. Flower garden. | Backyard composters. |
| Sewage Waste | Septic system waste. | Licensed sewage haulers. |
| Industrial Process Waste | Sludges from industrial processes. Waste containing unacceptable levels of toxic components. | An approved contaminated waste disposal site. |
| Animal Carcasses | Livestock Wildlife | An approved handler of animal carcass waste. |
| Vehicles & Equipment | Automobiles & Motorcycles Motor Homes Yachts | Auto wreckers. |
| Hazardous or Contaminated Materials | As defined in Regulation #347 of the Ontario Environmental Protection Act | The bi-annual County Hazardous Waste Disposal event, or an approved contaminated waste disposal site. |
