As an annual fundraiser, the Spencerville Mill Foundation challenges poker players to collect the best hand - while traversing down the South Nation River.

Beginning from O'Hagens Bridge on County Road 18, approximately 3 km south of Roebuck and 8 km north of Prescott, participants are given a card from a deck at five checkpoints along the river. The player who manages the best hand upon arrival at the Spencerville Mill will win first selection over the many great prizes donated by regional sponsors. Remaining prizes will be awarded in order of winning poker hands.

The event takes approximately two hours to complete and will be held Saturday, May 14, 2011 with registration at 09:00 a.m. and departure at 10:00 a.m. from O'Hagens Bridge. Participants who do not have their own canoe or kayak may book one in advance on a first come first serve basis courtesy of the Grenville Fish and Game Club.
